



Service Limitations

Brunswick Pointe Transitional Care, (hereafter referred to as “Facility”), cannot care for every applicant who wishes to receive services. The Facility has certain limitations due to size, location, composition, staffing and equipment. The facility cannot care for residents with any of the following diagnoses and/or identified problems:

- Ventilator patients
- Persons who are registered sex offenders
- Persons with major mental illness diagnosis
- Persons with drug or alcohol dependence, including actively detoxing from drugs or alcohol
- Persons under the age of 18
- Persons who are pregnant
- Brunswick Pointe Transitional Care reserves the right to review each potential admission for medical complexity and the ability of the facility and current staff to care for same

Residents and/or Resident Representatives are required to disclose all conditions and diagnosis prior to/or upon an admission to our facility, and we will discuss these service limitations with you upon admission. If you fail to disclose any of the above conditions at the time of admission, the Facility may seek to discharge you if we can no longer meet your needs.
